I have photographed more than 50 theatrical performances. Sleeping Beauty is the one shown here. Each performance is shot with approximately 700-1400 pictures. Movie Posters are actually composed of 8-20 pictures each at 18 megapixels from a canon 7D and then striped together and various photoshop effects applied. The result is a 20" x 30" poster with stunning detail. Approximately 400 to 800 of the best pictures are used for a Photo CD. The pictures are also purposed for video use in DVD menus, CD and DVD labels, Case Covers, and Cast Photos all shown below.
