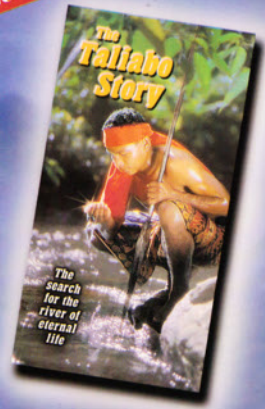


New Video Release

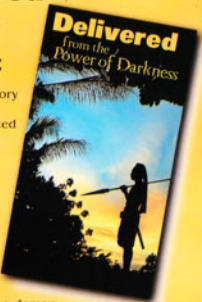
